**DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

Due to participation in the Probable Cause Panel, Mr. Hendriksen was recused from tabs 1 through 7 and tab 10. Mr. Fields was recused from tabs 8 and 9.

**MOTION FOR BOARD'S FINAL ORDER BY SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

**TAB 1 Gonzalo Del Monte, CRT, DOH Case No: 2012-03885  
Settlement Agreement, (PCP Members – Hendriksen, Nunez)**

Respondent was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Rossitto Van-Winkle summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: Section 468.365 (1)(x), through a violating Section 456.072 (1)(hh), Florida Statutes (2011), by failing to successfully complete a drug or alcohol treatment program.

The case was presented as a Settlement Agreement that would impose the following penalties:

- Appearance
- Fine of \$250.00 to be paid within three (3) years of the filing of the Final Order
- Costs of \$3,500.00 to be paid within three (3) years of the filing of the Final Order
- Suspension of license until Respondent presents a favorable PRN evaluation, stating he is able to return to practice with reasonable skill and safety. If recommended by PRN, Respondent shall submit proof of execution and compliance with a PRN monitoring contract within sixty (60) days of entry of Final Order. The Board delegated authority to the Department to lift suspension once PRN determines the Respondent is able to return practice.

Ms. Debbie Troupe, with PRN, explained the process of the program for the Respondent.

**MOTION:** Ms. Sherrod made a motion to delegate authority to the Department to lift suspension once Respondent is compliant with the PRN agreement. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fields and carried 40.
