**DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

**DISCIPLINARY VOLUNTARY RELINQUISHMENT**

1. Stella Denise Day, R.R.T., Case No: 2016-18777 (PCP, Colon & Nunez)

Respondent was not present nor represented by Counsel.

Ms. Iglehart summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: Section 468.365 (1)(x), Florida Statutes (2015), through a violation of Section 456.072 (1) (aa), Florida Statutes (2015), by violating provisions of this chapter or chapter 456, or any rules adopted, by testing positive for any drug, as defined in s. 112.0455, on any confirmed preemployment or employer-ordered drug screening when the practitioner does not have a lawful prescription and legitimate medical reason for using the drug.

The case was presented as a motion of Board's Final Order by Voluntary Relinquishment.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Dr. Friday-Stroud made a motion to accept the Voluntary Relinquishment.

The motion was seconded by Ms. Hom and carried 5/0.

2. Carrie Noell Deckard, C.R.T., Case No: 2017-00217 (PCP, Frey & Nunez)

Respondent was not present nor represented by Counsel.

Ms. Iglehart summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: Section 468.365 (1)(x), Florida Statutes (2016), through a violation of Section 456.072 (1)(hh), Florida Statutes (2016), by violating provisions of this chapter or chapter 456, or any rules adopted, by being terminated from a treatment program for impaired practitioners, for failure to comply, without good cause, with the terms of the monitoring or treatment contract entered by the licensee.

The case was presented as a motion of Board's Final Order by Voluntary Relinquishment.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Dr. Friday-Stroud made a motion to accept the Voluntary Relinquishment.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Garcia and carried 5/0.

### **REQUEST FOR EXTENSION TO PAY FINES AND COSTS**

3. Bradley Jones, R.R.T., Case No: 2011-16478 (PCP, Fields and Nunez)

Mr. Jones is requesting a modification of his Final Order, by granting an extension to pay fines and costs of the expense generated in DOH Case No: 2011-16478.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Frey made a motion to deny Mr. Jones' request.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Broeker and carried 5/1. Mr. Colon opposed.

**MOTION:** After further discussion, Dr. Friday-Stroud made a motion to revote on the previous motion. The motion was seconded by Mr. Colon and failed 2/4. Mr. Broeker, Ms. Hom, Mr. Frey, and Mr. Garcia opposed.

The original motion stays, and Mr. Jones' request is denied.

5. Zachary Joseph Foster, Registered Respiratory Therapist

He was requested to appear before the board due to the "yes" answer in the personal and criminal history sections of his application.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Dr. Friday-Stroud made a motion to grant licensure with the following conditions:

- Applicant shall make contact with the Florida Professionals Resource Network (PRN) within 30 days, undergo an evaluation coordinated by PRN within 60 days of the filing of the Order and if recommended, comply with any and all terms or conditions imposed by PRN within 90 days of the filing of the Order as a result of said evaluation.
- Staff may issue license if PRN deems applicant safe to practice.

She was requested to appear before the board due to the “yes” answer in the personal history section of her application.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Dr. Friday-Stroud made a motion to grant licensure with no conditions. The motion was seconded by Mr. Colon and carried 6/0.
