**DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

**MOTION FOR BOARD'S FINAL ORDER BY SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

1. Kevin Cox, R.R.T., Case No: 2017-20863 (PCP, Colon and Nunez)

Respondent was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Iglehart summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violations: **Count I**, Section 468.365 (1)(x), Florida Statutes (2002), through a violation of Section 456.072(1)(w), Florida Statutes (2002). **Count II**, Section 468.365 (1)(x), Florida Statutes (2002), through a violation of Section 456.072(1)(w), Florida Statutes (2002), by violating any provision of this chapter or chapter 456, by being convicted of neglect of a child and driving under the influence and failing to report that conviction to the Board in writing within 30 days.

The case was presented as a Settlement Agreement that would impose the following penalties:

- Reprimand
- Fine of \$600.00 to be paid within one (1) year of the filing of the Final Order
- Costs of \$548.56 to be paid within one (1) year of the filing of the Final Order
- Respondent must enroll in and successfully complete ten (10) hours of continuing education in laws and rules and proof of completion must be submitted to the Compliance Officer within one (1) year of the filing of the Final Order.

Ron Mitchell recused himself due to personal association with the Respondent.
